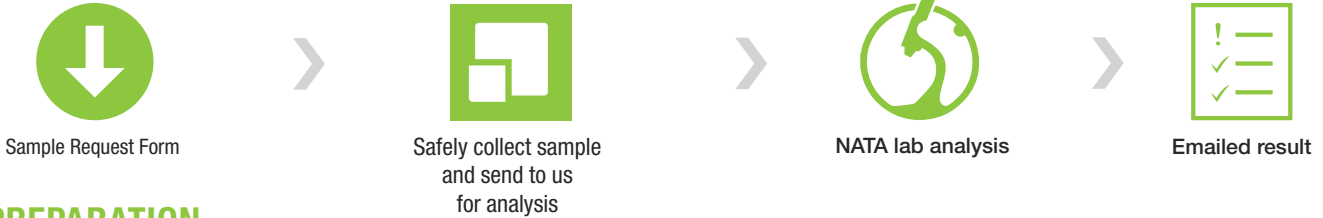


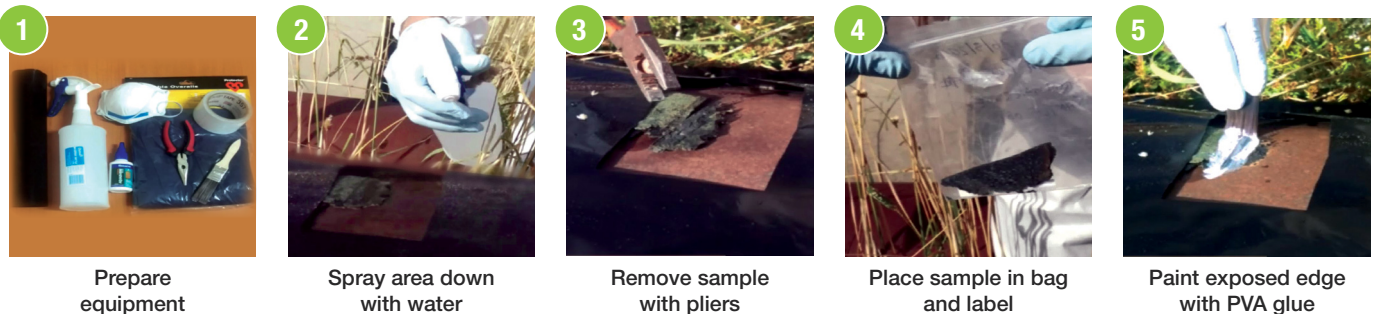
## HOW TO TEST MATERIAL FOR ASBESTOS



## PREPARATION

For bonded material including vinyl floor tiles and suspected non-friable asbestos:

- Lay down a plastic drop sheet to catch any loose material that may fall off while sampling.
- Turn off any fans or air conditioning if you're inside. If outside, then sample on a non-windy day.
- Put on Class P2 respirator mask and wear a pair of disposable coveralls.



## SAMPLING PROCEDURE (NON-FRIABLE MATERIAL)

- Dampen down the area with the water spray bottle.
- Remove a representative sample (30mm x 30mm) of material with clean pliers. Select a sample from a corner edge or along an existing hole, crack, or behind power point. If the edge is exposed, apply PVA glue to seal any fibres.
- Place sample into a resealable plastic bag, and double bag.
- Label with the Date, Site Details, Sample Number and Sample Location.
- Complete the Chain of Custody Form (see over) & **send in a padded sealed envelope contained within a hard shelled container to minimise risk of damage .**
- Costs are AUD\$80 (Approx. USD\$56) per sample.
- Affix attached Label

A NATA laboratory analysis report will be emailed or mailed to you with results indicating the type of fibres present including any asbestos (eg. Chrysotile, Amosite or Crocidolite).

Thank you for your letter of 25 May 2018 about Regional EnviroScience Pty Ltd's request for a permit renewal to continue importing samples of asbestos for analysis.

Based on the information in your application letter and advice from the Asbestos Safety and Eradication Agency, I am satisfied that the purpose of the importation is for analysis.

As the Minister administering the *Work Health and Safety Act 2011*, I grant permission to Regional EnviroScience Pty Ltd to import samples of asbestos for the period ending 30 June 2019 in accordance with:

- Subsection 4C(2) of the *Customs (Prohibited Imports) Regulations 1956* in respect of possible amphibole asbestos samples
- Subsection 4C(6) of the *Customs (Prohibited Imports) Regulations 1956* in respect of possible chrysotile asbestos samples.

The new permit number is MB18-000229.
